



XP-51A & P-51A "Shanty Irish" - NOVAMING24



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
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ABOUT



Initially ignored despite it's clear performance superiority over other airframes in service and undergoing testing, it would eventually evolve to become one of the most iconic fighters of all the Second World War.

SN 41-039 was one of the two examples evaluated by the USAAF in October of 1941. The other is 41-038 and is preserved at the EAA Aviation Museum at Oshkosh.

N51X (43-6006) was a P-51A produced in 1943 and served with USAAF before crashing in Alaska. It was recovered in 1977 and was eventually restored to airworthy condition. In 2005 she raced at Reno for the first time as Polar Bear and was a regular sight until she disappeared form the circuit in 2012.

In 2017 she reappeared this time restored to resemble 41-039, and adopted the racing moniker "Shanty Irish" and sporting race number #6.

This pack includes both XP-51A prototypes as they apeared during their test flight careers as well as N51X as she appeared during the 2017 racing season.

INSTALLATION


2. Run the N24 NAA XP-51A Liveries v2.0.exe

3. Follow the on-screen prompts

UNINSTALLATION

 Navigate to your Windows > Settings > Apps > Apps & Features

2. Locate and Uninstall *N24 NAA XP-*51A Liveries from the displayed list.





PILOTS NOTES

This pack has been more challenging than I expected, mostly due to some of the choices of the original developers with how the UV Maps are done.

For example the canopy frame and the actuator of the rudder trim are not strictly correct due to the UV map, but I believe they are compromises we can work with.


Nevertheless, despite making some compromises around the colour of the canopy frame, I am very pleased with how this has turned out!



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
